PLEASE READ BEFORE ENTERING:

Horse and rider combinations can stay at the same level throughout the Winter League

NB. Other than the Pairs class horses may only compete in consecutive levels

Horse/rider combinations can only enter one class at the same level

Run under BD and BRC Rules

Horses must be 4yrs old or over and Riders 18yrs or over

1st placed combinations from previous years may still compete at the same level, but will not be eligible to win the same league for a second time. (Elementary, Medium & Pairs exempt)

Class 1: Introductory 2 (2024) - Restricted to horse/rider combinations who have not won 2 or more Intro tests, and not gained 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any Dressage competition at Prelim level or higher. Horse/rider combination may only also enter class 2 or 4. No HC entries.

Class 2: Preliminary 2 (2024) Restricted - Restricted to horse /rider combinations who have not gained 1st, 2nd or 3rd more than twice at Prelim level or higher.

Class 3: Pairs PYO Introductory 2 (2024) or Preliminary 2 (2024) – One horse must be Intro, Prelim or Novice level the other can be any level. Pairs will ride either the Intro test or the Prelim test and the winners will be the pair with the highest percentage. Please declare your test in the notes.

Class 4: Preliminary 2 (2024) Open - Open to combinations who are not competing & have never competed at Elementary level.

Class 5 Novice 2 (2024) Restricted – Restricted to horse /rider combinations who are not competing & have never competed at Elementary level.

Class 6 Novice 2 (2024) Open – Open to combinations who are not competing & have never competed at Medium level.

Class 7 Elementary 2 (2024) Open

Class 8 Medium 2 (2024) Open

Please use your own bib with printed or written number or bridle or saddle pad number to display your competitor number. **Numbers to be displayed on both sides.**

Your Responsibility

All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards
Your safety is your own responsibility. EFRA & STABLE LIFE DO NOT accept responsibility for any accident, or damage to you, your horse, your vehicle or associates whatsoever and however caused. It is a condition of the club that this is understood and by entering you are agreeing to these conditions.

General information

Please ensure that you do not muck out your horsebox onto parking area. Take all litter home with you. All riders and helpers must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Rudeness will not be tolerated.

Hats must be worn at all times when mounted and must comply to the current BETA Standards (see below). Hair must be above the collar and long hair secured with a hairnet.
Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended or tied to the outside of trailers/lorries.

WARM UP area – 5 horses max and you are only allowed to re-enter the arena to warm up at a suitable time for any next class. Please encourage any helpers to lift droppings.

Hat/Body Protector Rules

Under BRC rules applying to this event, all riders when mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat complying with one of the following specifications and with the strap properly adjusted and fastened. Only the following specifications are acceptable at any BRC competition:

- i. PAS015 (2011) **and must have** official BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark
- ii. VG1 01.040 (2014-12) **and must have** official BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark
- iii. ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) **and must have** official SEI mark
- iv. SNELL E2016 **and must have** official SNELL label and number
- v. AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) **and must have** official SAI global mark
- vi. EN1384:2023 **and must have** BSI kitemark or Inspec IC mark

It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they are wearing hats to the correct standard. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified. Riders should be aware that riding in a hat which is not up to the standard specified above may invalidate any insurance.

Body protectors BETA Level 3 Blue 2018 Label

The ONLY exception to the requirement for a BETA Level 3 2009 purple label is that Exo Body Cages will continue to be accepted, provided they have a BETA Level 3 2000 purple label & the competitor must inform the event secretary. If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector for cross-country it must be worn over a permitted BETA Level 3 body protector and if activated, must be deflated or removed before continuing. Hybrid Air-jackets and air jackets incorporated into a blouson style jacket are permitted. It is recommended that body protectors are replaced once they are more than 5 years old.
