Horse and rider combinations can stay at the same level throughout the Winter League

Class 1 Intro B (2009) - Restricted to horse/rider combinations who have not won an Intro test, and not gained 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any Dressage competition at Prelim level or higher. Restricted to first 10 entries. Horse/rider combination may only also enter class 2. No HC entries. There will be a waiting list if class over subscribed

Class 2 P2 (2006) - Restricted to horse /rider combinations have not gained 1st, 2nd or 3rd more than twice at Prelim level or higher. Entrants may not compete in Classes 5 & 6

Class 3 P7 (2016) – Open to combinations who are not competing & have never competed at Elementary level. Entrants may not enter Classes 5 or 6

Class 4A – N27 (2007) – Sec A entrants cannot enter Classes 4B, 5 or 6

Class 4B - N27 (2007) - Sec B Open horse/rider combinations cannot enter Classes 4A or 6

Class 5 E42 (2008) - Open

Class 6 M71 (2002) - Open

Horses competing at Prelim level may not compete at Elementary or Medium. Horses competing at Novice level may not compete at Medium.

General information

Please ensure that you do not muck out your horsebox onto parking area. Take all litter home with you.

All riders and helpers must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Rudeness will not be tolerated.

Hats must be worn at all times when mounted and must comply to the current BETA Standards (see below). Hair must be above the collar and long hair secured with a hairnet.

Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended or tied to the outside of trailers/lorries
Only 1 helper per horse

Social distancing must be adhered to at all times Face coverings to be worn at all times when inside with the exception when mounted

Please be on site for minimum time, arrive ride and leave

Any information given on entering will only be used for the purposes of this competition and will not be passed on to any third party

<u>Under BRC rules applying to this event, all riders when mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat complying with one of the following specifications and with the strap properly adjusted and fastened. Only the following specifications are acceptable at any BRC competition</u>

- i) PAS015 (1998 or 2011) and must have official BSI Kite mark
- ii) VG1 01.040 (2014-12) and must have official BSI Kite mark
- iii) ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) and must have official SEI Mark
- iv) SNELL E2001 and must have official SNELL label and number
- v) AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) and must have official SAI global mark

It is the riders responsibility to ensure they are wearing hats to the correct standard. Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified. Riders should be aware that riding in a hat which is not up to the standard specified above may invalidate any insurance

Body protectors must be BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2009 label.

The ONLY exception to the requirement for a BETA Level 3 2009 purple label is that Exo Body Cages will continue to be accepted, provided they have a BETA Level 3 2000 purple label & the competitor must inform the event secretary
